CAPITAL BUILDING PROJECT: PLANNING TODAY FOR OUR CHILDREN'S FUTURE

The Chittenango Central School District has a proud history of providing excellent programs and facilities for our children. This success is the result of thoughtful and measured improvement programs over the years that have been designed to protect the district's investments. Sometimes this means replacing items due to normal wear and tear, such as roofs and parking lots. Other projects are program related, such as upgrades to classrooms and technology infrastructure. The key is staying current with the latest program and facilities developments and taking advantage of the availability of state funding.



The Chittenango school district has been careful in monitoring and cataloging facility items in need of improvement. Our state-required Building Condition Survey also recommended improvements to address a number of building facility deficiencies, including elements that do not meet the current building code. The Board of Education has worked with their architect to develop a plan for addressing identified building improvement needs.

The project scope includes health and safety improvements, security upgrades, and energy-saving improvements to the district, along with renovations to areas for enhanced educational programs, construction of a new transportation facility, and construction of a four-classroom addition at Bolivar Road Elementary School.

The overall project will cost \$11,850,000. The vote on the project will be on **May 21, 2013.**



SOURCES OF FUNDS

This project has been planned to take the best advantage of the district's high state aid rate (86%) combined with state EXCEL funds and the district's capital reserves. The vast majority of items included in this \$11,850,000 project will qualify for state aid reimbursement to the District.
