2. Secretary's Report

The minutes from the preceding meeting were not available for review. Jennifer has met with Tammy O'Connell and has been updated on the duties and responsibilities of the secretary. In addition, access to the CMBA email address and password have been shared.

3. Treasurer's Report

- 2. Fund Raising- Due to the current pandemic, fund raising via food and beverage sales may again be limited this year. As a result, the CMBA may need to focus on merchandise sales as a way to generate funds this school year.
- 3. Open Houses- At this time, it is unknown whether open houses will be allowed this school year. If they are held, the CMBA will have a presence at each one to provide information on our mission and promote memberships.
- 4. Apparel Update- Natalie is waiting on one more item and then she will submit the last bill from the apparel sales to Melissa.
- 5. The Cortney Elmy Memorial Fund- Cortney was a Chittenango Central School student who graduated in 2016. While at Chittenango, Cortney was heavily involved in music programs- she played the piano, sang in chorus and participated in the musicals. Unfortunately, Cortney passed away this year and funds have since been raised by her family and friends to honor her memory. It was discussed that at the next general meeting in September a motion will need to be made to determine how the funds will be allotted in collaboration with the family's wishes.
