

Hello Bridgeport Families!

Our students have been doing an excellent job with learning and participating in our Second Step Program. I visit each classroom (K-4) every week to teach a new topic or skill for learning. I am not sure where the time has gone, but we have wrapped up our

first unit! We have learned how to be respectful listeners, how to show empathy, how to focus our attention, how to effectively use self-talk and how to be assertive. Currently, we are focusing on how to respect each other's differences, including thoughts and opinions. In the past, Bridgeport has offered a school-wide character education assembly to learn more about the important character traits, which we call "pillar words." Bridgeport's 5 pillar words include respect, responsibility, perseverance, kindness, and courage. This year, teachers will record a presentation and each teacher will play the video for their class. The first virtual assembly will happen in November and will concentrate on the pillar words "respect" and "responsibility."

Additionally, we used to break into small groups a few times a year to talk about the character traits even further. Kindergarten-second grade students participate in what we call "Lighthouse Meetings" and third and fourth grade students participate in "Courageous Conversations." This year, I will provide these lessons to each class individually in person. Students learn more about the character trait and lesson through short stories and discussions.

5 Suggestions for a Successful Parent/Teacher Conference:

- Plan for it. Before meeting, write out questions you would like to ask, such as "What is my child's attitude regarding learning?" "Does my child show respect for others?" "Does he/she accept responsibility for his/her own behavior?" "Does my child seem happy in school?" "What are my child's strengths?"
- Keep an open mind. Your goal is to work cooperatively with your child's teacher so that your child experiences many successes throughout the year. Even if the teacher says something you disagree with, try to listen to what he/she has to say.
- Ask to see your child's work. If your child is doing well, ask what you can do
 to keep things on a positive track. If there are problems, ask what you can do
 to help or offer suggestions that have worked for you.
- Clarify and summarize as you go. If you don't understand something the teacher says, ask for clarification.
- Ask what you can do to support your child's learning at home and at school.
