Dear Parente,

The following are some of the tools that your child will need for third grade. Please write your child's name on supplies coming to school.

- 1. Wide ruled loose leaf paper to be put in a simple pocket folder
- 2. #2 pencils with erasers Please send in a bunch of pencils in a Ziploc bag with your child's name on it.

 We will keep this supply in school. When more are needed, a note will be sent home.
- 3. 8 simple pocket folders used to store materials (Please do not buy bulky binders.)
- 4. I box of colored pencile quantity is your choice I will provide orayons.
- 5. I blue or black ink pen used for corrections
- 6. 1 zippered or sealed supply bag/box for storage of student pencils inside desks
- 7. 2 boxes of tissues unopened, to be shared with the class throughout the year
- 8. A small group of pictures that will not be returned. We will be using them for a project. These pictures are separate from the items to share the first week of school. Pictures can be of family, friends, pets, etc.
- 9: Glue sticks any size
- 10. Headphones or earbude in a baggie with student name on it.
