Counselor Corner

Learning how to manage and organize time is an important skill for middle school students. Parents can assist with this by structuring study time and helping their child find a healthy balance of work, rest, and play.

Establish a set time for homework every day, and use our school websites to monitor assignments and scheduled activities. Also, maintain the expectation that your child will use his/her agenda to keep track of assigned school work and review it every day with your child.

Help your child find the best time to work on assignments at home. For some it is best to complete school work immediately after school. For others a rest or activity break is helpful to allow the student to recharge after a day of classes. Experiment to find the best schedule that works for your child and fits in with your family's daily routine.

Encourage short regular breaks during work sessions at home. It is usually more productive for a middle school student to work for 20 minutes with a short break then another 20 minutes of study. The breaks help keep the brain alert and focused.

Create a calendar with your child that includes study and homework time, sports and club activities, and other family happenings. Have your child write down due dates for big assignments and tests. Help him/her find time to prepare to meet deadlines and work around extra-curricular activities. When involvement in too many activities seem to cause a decline in school performance, guide your child in making the decision to eliminate an activity. Set a regular bed time so your child gets enough rest each night, and be sure to find time to enjoy having fun as a family.
