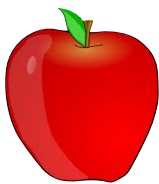

## **Changes to NYS Health Examination Requirements Effective July 2018**

Starting July 2018, mandates in Education Law with regards to physical exams were changed. Health examinations will be required for each student in kindergarten, first, third, fifth, seventh, ninth, and eleventh grades. All students who are entering the school district for the first time, students receiving certain special education services, and all students involved in interscholastic athletics.

Health examinations may be performed at school by the School Medical Director or performed by the student's primary medical provider. They must be dated no more than twelve months prior to the start of the school year in which they are required or the date of entrance to the school for new entrants.
