Principals' Message

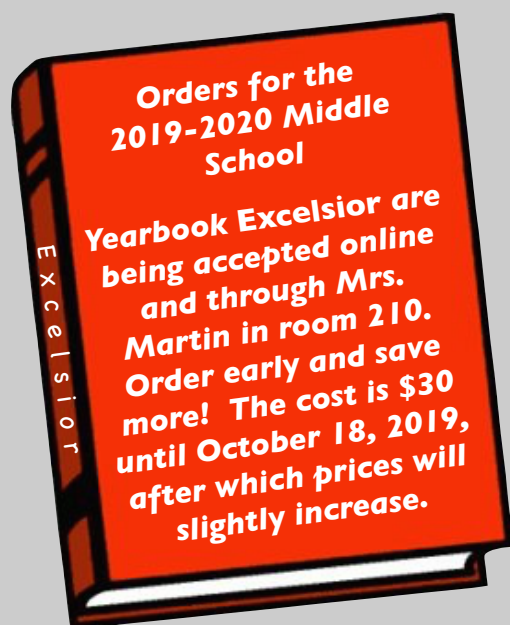

Here are just a few reminders for the school year. We will soon be into the cold and flu season. If any child has been home or sent home from school with a temperature or vomiting, it is a good idea that the child be fever free for 24 hours without the use of analgesics or free from vomiting for 24 hours before returning to school. If a child needs to take any medication, doctor's orders and parental permission are required. A parent/guardian must bring the medicine to school for the student. **No child should bring any medicine to school.**

All students in K, 1st, 3rd, 5th, 7th, 9th or 11th grades and all students new to the school district must have a physical either from a private physician or it will be done at school in October. If you have any health related questions, please feel free to call me at 315-687-2810.
