#### **Student Cell Phone Procedure**

#### **Special Transportation Requests**

If you are planning to pick up your child early or want him/ her to get off the bus at a different location, please help us by doing the following:

- Always send a written note stating specifically your child's destination or pick-up time.
- Please avoid phoning in a request and never send a verbal message with your child (for example, "tell your teacher, I'll be picking you up today").
- Try to avoid unnecessary bus passes (for example, sending your child to a friend's house to play).
- If you are picking up your child at dismissal, be here at 2:12 p.m. before the buses leave. \*Please be aware that if we have not received written notification or a telephone call and you have not arrived to pick him/her up by the time buses are ready to leave, your child will be sent home on the bus.
- If you plan to transport your child from school on a regular basis, written notification must be sent informing the office.
- If you are dropping off your child in the morning, he/she she should arrive between 7:20 a.m. and 7:25 a.m. We do not provide supervision before 7:10 a.m.

We appreciate your efforts to communicate with us about your child's transportation schedule change. Thank you for your continued cooperation.

#### What to Wear

Recess: The days are getting cooler in CNY and students go outside almost every day. Students should be prepared with a jacket, sweatshirt, hat, gloves, etc.

Physical Education Class: Students are reminded that they must have appropriate athletic wear for class. This is to include sneakers designed for athletics, worn with socks, as well as shorts, sweats, wind pants, or stretch pants, and a t-shirt. Jeans, dress slacks, platform sneakers, and other types of street clothes and shoes do not meet the requirements for physical education class.

If you are volunteering in the building, have a scheduled meeting or visitation with teachers, or are picking up your child, please report to the office to sign in when you arrive.
