In an event like this, parents will be notified through an Urgent Alert using ParentSquare. Dependent upon your notification settings, you will receive a phone call and/or text message indicating our status during weather events. Also, we ask that you pay attention to local TV/radio stations whenever there is inclement weather, as updates will be available there as soon as a decision is made to delay, close, or dismiss early. On those few occasions, it is very important that you and your child(ren) have a plan to where they would go in the event of an early closing. A pink form was filled out with this information at the beginning of the school year. Please let your child's teacher know if this information has changed so a new form can be sent home.

Classroom teachers take students outside for recess in the winter, as long as the temperature or wind chill is not too cold. Please make sure your child has the proper clothing needed to go outside: boots/gloves/hat/winter coat. Label all items: this is helpful at all grade levels.

If your child rides a school bus, please take the time to remind them to look at the driver and wait for their signal to ensure it is safe to cross the road.


