The cold and flu season is upon us. Any child who has been home or sent home from school with a temperature should be fever free for 24 hours without any fever reducer medication. We recommend they are free from vomiting for 24 hours before they return to school.

If a child needs to take any medication at school, physician orders and parental permission is required. The medication has to be brought by an adult to school.

Students in UPK, kindergarten, grades 1, 3 and new students are required to have a physical. Physicals done by the child's physician should be given to the school nurse as soon as possible.
