# Cost-Effective Purchase No additional expense to districts

Onondaga-Cortland-Madison BOCES has an opportunity to purchase the former Nationwide Building in the Town of Salina. This acquisition means **no additional cost** to our districts.

Currently, OCM BOCES owns two facilities and leases eight more. A building purchase reallocates some of the current rental budget and allows those funds to be used to buy this building.

#### **Building Purchase Results In:**

- No additional cost to component districts
- Improved facilities for all our students
- The ability to control growth of capital/ rental costs
- Adequate instructional space to meet increasing demands
- The capability to better meet the needs of component districts and local businesses
