SCHOOL DISTRICT GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

To further its educational philosophy, the Board of Education establishes the following goals and objectives:

- 1. to encourage the development of positive and supportive interpersonal relationships among the students, the staff and members of the community;
- 2. to ensure that staff, students, and parents are afforded opportunities for meaningful participation in the development and evaluation of programs and policies;
- 3. to strive for maximum efficiency in the use of district resources to meet the goals and objectives of the various programs and services;
- 4. to provide opportunities for students to develop proficiency in basic academic skills as defined by the Board of Regents and local school standards;
- 5. to promote the development of programs and services which encourage cooperative interaction between the community-at-large and district staff and students;
- 6. to provide opportunities for students to develop the capacity to recognize and cope with social and personal problems in the present and future;
- 7. to promote the development of good character by making an individual aware of the consequences of his behavior upon others as well as himself;
- 8. to make students aware of differing cultural, racial, and social backgrounds;
- 9. to provide opportunities for students to participate in programs in the creative and fine arts; and
- 10. to provide opportunities for continuous professional growth in order to better serve the student body.

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
