COMMUNITY RELATIONS GOALS

The Board of Education shall interpret the district's educational program to the citizens, staff, and students and invite discussions and suggestions on important educational policies and shall attempt, at all times, to represent the entire community rather than any single group or section. To this end, the Board establishes the following district school-community relations goals:

- 1. To develop responsible citizen, staff and student understanding of the school system in all aspects of its operations.
- 2. To determine how the citizens, staff, and students feel about the school system and what it wishes the school system to accomplish.
- 3. To develop citizen, staff, and student understanding of the need for adequate financial support for a sound educational program.
- 4. To earn the good will, respect, and confidence of the citizenry, staff, and students.
- 5. To bring about citizen, staff, and student understanding of the needs for the improvement and what must be done to facilitate essential change.
- 6. To establish cordial relations with other public agencies and to promote their understanding of the educational programs and facilities.
- 7. To promote a genuine spirit of cooperation between the Board, staff, student body, and citizens in sharing leadership for the improvement of the community.
- 8. To promote the use of and respect for school property by community groups.

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
