SCHOOL ATTORNEY

The Board of Education will appoint a School Attorney for the district. The Attorney must be admitted to the bar of New York State.

Selection of Attorney/Law Firm

In selecting a School Attorney, the district will prepare a well-planned, written request for a proposal which will contain critical details of the services sought and submit this request to prospective applicants.

The district will consider the cost of a retainer (or hourly fee), as well as such other factors as:

- 1. the special knowledge or expertise of the lawyer/law firm;
- 2. the quality of the service provided by the lawyer/law firm;
- 3. the staffing of the lawyer/law firm; and
- 4. the lawyer's/law firm's suitability for the district's needs.

The district will maintain documentation of the written proposals submitted by lawyer/law firm applicants for the position of School Attorney.
