

DOUBLING UP ON COURSES AT THE HIGH SCHOOL LEVEL

The Board of Education desires the best education possible for all of the students in the district. Within the high school setting, priorities are established and standards are created with the expectation that they will be achieved.

In spite of these efforts, students who do not pass a course and who do not successfully complete the course in summer school, are required to repeat the course for a full year.

Students who do not pass an English and/or social studies course(s) and do not successfully complete the course in summer school, will not be allowed to enroll in two levels of an English and/or social studies course (i.e. double up), during an academic year. Students must attain a passing grade and corresponding course credit before they enroll in the next level of a course.

As an exception to this policy, students in their senior year of high school may be allowed to enroll in two levels of a required English and/or social studies course (i.e. double up).
