ASSIGNMENT OF STUDENTS TO CLASSES

Students entering the elementary schools will normally be assigned to the building which services the area in which they live (catchment area). The boundaries of these neighborhoods may be adjusted from year to year and students may be reassigned to another school based on the district's enrollment and program needs. A student may also be reassigned to another school when deemed on the pupil's best interests.

If a child relocates to a new catchment area within the district during any school year between September 1 and June 30, the child's parents will retain the choice of:

- a. Enrolling the child in the school which serves the new catchment area, or
- b. Allowing the child to remain in the original school only until the end of the school year, providing that the parent can provide for all transportation necessary for attendance in that school.

Transportation will be provided for each child only within the catchment area of the child's current residence.

Assignment of students and classes to individual teachers is made by the Building Principal in elementary, middle and high schools.
