STUDENT ABSENCES AND EXCUSES

The following reasons for student absences from schools are recognized as valid by the Board of Education:

- 1. illness
- 2. 3. illness or death in the family
- 4.
- unsafe travel conditions religious observance medical appointments 5.
- 6. quarantine
- 7. required court appearances
- approved college visits 8.
- approved cooperative work programs 9.

Any other absence is considered unexcused. Each absence must be accounted for. It is the parent's/guardian's responsibility to notify the office on the morning of the absence. It is essential that parents/guardians provide a written excuse for each absence. Such excuse should contain the reason and date of absence.
