## **BUDGET ADOPTION**

Final approval of the tentative budget rests with the Board of Education. The Superintendent of Schools and such members of his/her staff as he/she shall deem necessary, shall be prepared to explain and justify the budget to the Board. Final authorization of the budget rests with the voters of the district.

The proposed budget indicating the total expenditure called for, therein, shall be presented to the voters of the district for adoption in accordance with the date prescribed in State law.

Individuals desiring to submit questions, propositions, or amendments to be placed on the ballot shall conform to the requirements set forth in policy 1050.
