FACILITIES DEVELOPMENT GOALS

The Board of Education shall propose to the community, the construction of school buildings or the expansion, alteration, or modernization of present buildings to meet the demands of present and future school enrollment and in doing so, provide an educational environment of the highest quality at a reasonable expenditure of tax dollars.

The Board will annually consider specific objectives for the development, renovation, repair, and maintenance of district facilities pertaining to, but not limited to the following:

- adequate space;
- program involvement;
- health and safety;
- provisions for people with disabilities;
- energy conservation; and
- general upkeep, and any other needs that can be included in the budget.

In preparing proposals for new buildings or renovations, consideration will be given to the viewpoints and needs of students, staff, parents and other taxpayers.

Architects employed by the Board will be expected to plan for simplicity of design; sound economics, including low-range maintenance and operating costs and low insurance rates; high educational utility and flexibility.

In carrying out facilities development goals the Board will adhere to the requirements of Commissioner's Regulations.
