FIELD TRIP AND EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITY TRANSPORTATION

Upon approval of the Business Administrator, school vehicles may be used to transport students on field trips or for extracurricular activities. General bus procedures should be followed for extracurricular bus use.

Whenever the district provides transportation to students on a school-sponsored field trip, extracurricular activity or any other similar event, it shall provide transportation back to either the point of departure or to the appropriate school in the district unless:

- 1. the parent or legal guardian of a student participating in such event has provided the district with written authorization for an alternative form of return transportation for the student; or
- 2. intervening circumstances make such transportation impractical.

Where intervening circumstances have made transportation back to the point of departure or to the appropriate school in the district impractical, a representative of the district shall remain with the student until such student's parent or legal guardian has been contacted and the student has been delivered to his/her parent or legal guardian.
