

SPECIAL USE OF SCHOOL BUSES

The Board of Education permits some special uses of school buses, such as providing transportation to participants in interscholastic athletics or field days, music trips and field trips that are part of the instructional program. Such transportation will be provided at district expense when approved by the Building Principal or the Superintendent of Schools.

Spectator buses and buses for special projects of extracurricular organizations shall be provided whenever possible. Such trips shall require the prior approval of the Principal upon written application.

Buses may be leased to other organizations under conditions provided by law at no expense to the district.

Permission for all special use of school buses may be granted based upon review of such factors as the nature and legality of the use, the anticipated time a particular bus will be needed and the ability of the district to meet its normal transportation commitments.
