

FOOD SERVICE MANAGEMENT

The Board of Education recognizes that school cafeterias are a part of the total school program. In order to provide healthful, balanced meals during school hours, the district shall operate a food service program in each building. The food service program shall be under the direction of the Food Service Supervisor who shall report to the Business Administrator. In each building there shall be a cook/manager and an adequate staff of cooks and food service helpers.

Food services shall include lunches and breakfasts meeting the reimbursable requirement as well as milk, desserts and other a la carte items. The Board shall approve the prices set for reimbursable school lunches, breakfasts and milk.

As required for participation in the Child Nutrition Program, free and reduced price meals shall be provided to those whose applications are approved according to federal guidelines.

The food service supervisor shall be responsible under the supervision of the Business Administrator for the purchase of food and other supplies used in the food service program.
