Family and Medical Leave Act

The Board of Education recognizes that leaves of absence are occasionally necessary due to family or medical reasons. The Board of Education hereby authorizes the Superintendent to establish procedures to comply with the Family and Medical Leave Act of 1993 (FMLA). As will be provided by District regulations, eligible employees are entitled to use up to twelve (12) work weeks of leave for family and medical reasons recognized by the FMLA.
