Dear Parent/Guardian:

Education Law requires all New York State (NYS) public school students to have a health exam when they are a new student in a school district and when they enter Pre-K or Kindergarten, and grades 1, 3, 5, 7, 9, and 11.

**Beginning on 1/31/21, schools cannot accept the health exam if it is not on the required form or the required health record equivalent.**

We have enclosed a letter and copy of the required form with instructions for your health care provider (HCP). The form and instructions are also on our website at [www.chittenangoschools.org](http://www.chittenangoschools.org) and the NYS website at [www.schoolhealthny.com](http://www.schoolhealthny.com). Please share the enclosed papers at your child's visit for a health exam with the health care provider (HCP). This is typically your doctor but may be a nurse practitioner or physician assistant.
