## You will need these things for your first day of UPK:

• An extra full set of clothes in a bag, labeled with your name to stay at school

• A **DAILY healthy snack and water/school-appropriate drink**. No twist top capped disposable plastic water bottles, please, because at this age, these spill easily.

• A <u>lunch</u> if you do not choose to purchase a school lunch. It's helpful to "start" tears to open bags like chips, etc. It's great to have your child "practice" bringing lunch and eating it at home before they start school, so you can coach them in how to access the inside of packages, set up, and eat their food. For buyers, your child will have an account in the cafeteria. Reduced and free lunch applications will be sent home soon.

\*A backpack that fits your child comfortably and can carry projects, etc back home

## Here's a list of SUPPLIES you'll need for our class for Day 1:

• A plastic pencil case/box that will hold your crayons and pencils (much easier to find certain crayons in a case/box than in a zippered pouch), labeled with your child's name

- A pair of child-size scissors (Fiskars work well)
- 10 glue sticks to start (We'll store the extra sticks at school until needed)
- •5 to 10 pencils (regular #2 type pencils with erasers and/or wider pencils if you prefer)
- Three boxes of 8—12 crayons/box (We'll store the extra boxes at school until needed)
- 3 cans of Play-doh
- 2 watercolor boxes with paint brushes (A brush is usually included in the watercolor box)
- a box of facial tissues
- Three rolls of paper towels
- A box or two of sealable food storage, sandwich, or another size of plastic bags
- \* A box of sidewalk chalk
